This position will work with Group Director, Environmental & Sustainability to support Ryder field operations in understanding and developing strategies to comply with these new environmental regulations in the most cost effective manner and to leverage financial funding opportunities when available. Responsibilities will include:

- Monitor new federal, state and local regulations related to emission controls, fuel standards and climate change
- Ensure compliance with state-specific emission compliance requirements (i.e.: CARB) and new EPA regulations (Endangerment Rule)
- Provide management and accounting of greenhouse gas emissions for direct and indirect emission sources for company operations and customer services
